Partner Events

Requirements of Partner Status

- Must submit a program outline or brochure rough draft (along with a projected number of participants) to the PCCA Board for approval as a Partner event.
- Approved programs will be referred to as the PCCCA _____ and will need to use the PCCCA logo in their publicity materials.
- These programs must include an additional fee for non-PCCCA members who attend their event. This would look like a member discount on the registration form. This additional fee is to be collected by the host site and sent to the PCCCA Treasurer after the event.
- The PCCCA Executive Director or a Board designate will attend the event and will not be charged the program fee. This person will have access to the event's evaluation forms and will report these findings (along with their own reflections on the event) to the Board.

Benefits of Partner Status

- Partner events can apply for start-up funds (during their first three years) by submitting a
 program budget for approval by the PCCCA Board.
- Partner events will be the only programs which will appear in the calendar on the PCCCA
 website. This listing will consist of a paragraph description and a link to the event website
 or to a copy of the program brochure (on the PCCCA or the host site's website). This
 paragraph will also appear on the Bulletin Board page of up to four issues of Branches
 Online.
- The leaders of these events will receive the email addresses of the PCCCA membership and postal mailing addresses for the PCCCA membership and for all the camps and conference centers in the denomination.
- At the PCCCA Annual Conference, the leaders of a Partner event will receive time during special announcements or the business meeting to publicize their event.
- PCCCA will fund scholarships for up to 5% of the projected number of participants. This
 will cover only the program fee for the event and will be administered by the event leaders.

Endorsed Events

Requirements of Endorsed Status

 Must submit a program outline or brochure rough draft to the PCCCA Executive Director for approval as an Endorsed event.

Benefits of Endorsed Status

- Endorsed events can publicize their program by listing a paragraph description and a link to the event website on the Bulletin Board page of up to three issues of Branches Online.
- The leaders of these events will receive the postal mailing addresses for the PCCCA membership and for all the camps an conference centers in the denomination.
- At the PCCCA Annual Conference, the leaders of an Endorsed event will receive time during meals to publicize their event.
